Supply List

Students should provide:

- An apron
- A variety of freshly fallen leaves (nothing too crispy)
- A variety of papers, at least 10 sheets (printer paper, cardstock, colored, textured or printed paper, scrap papers, pack of 3x5 cards, etc)
- Baby wipes
- Paper towels or old washcloth or hand towel
- Acrylic paints, (any colors, any brand)
- A variety of *blunt* items to use and share for creating textures (ie: plastic netting, cardboard, bubble wrap, buttons, strings, rubber bands, rubber stamps, corks, etc)
- Micron pens, markers, paint brushes (optional)
- Tablecloth

DO NOT BRING: Any objects with sharp points or edges (they will pierce and ruin the gel plate)

Instructor will provide the following:

- A gel plate for each participant
- A variety of papers to try
- Some acrylic paints to share
- Brayer
- Leaves, stencils, items to create textures
- Paper cutter
- Glue
