Supply List

Materials and studio usage:

Students will be required to purchase additional materials and some tools to participate in class. The North Seattle College Jewelry Program is wonderful for allowing the Continuing Education students access to the jewelry studio and its many tools. There are consumable materials that are not provided (i.e. metal, solder, stones, etc).

*Students are encouraged to wait to purchase materials until after the first class. All materials are available locally, but students are more than welcome to purchase supplies online.

Supply list

Students will need to bring a few specific materials for class projects: (subject to change)

- Copper sheet (24ga, 6"x6" minimum, 20ga, 3"x2" minimum)
- 4mm Round CZ's (2 minimum)

At the Intermediate-level, students will already be familiar with some of the basic supplies that are needed in the studio. In addition to project-specific supplies, each student should also bring a toolbox containing (at minimum):

- Silver solder (in Easy, Medium, and Hard)
- Flux and brush
- Drill bits and Sawblades (2/0 recommended for general purpose)
- Sandpaper (320, 400, and 600 grits)
- Sheet Metal, wire, and gemstones for projects
- Extra Fine Sharpie and a pencil or pen for sketching
- Jewelry Notebook or Sketchbook
- Any personal tools that the student already owns, marked with their name

The class will create hollow forms with the hydraulic press; fabricate stone settings; and create hinges, all using copper and brass. If students would prefer to use silver for their projects, it will be their responsibility to purchase the material for that as well. The metal quantities listed above are approximate amounts that will be used in class. Some students work very quickly and some work more slowly and meticulously. Plan to bring the
