

Fall Quarter: Stone Setting

Materials and Studio Usage:

Students will be required to purchase additional materials and some tools to participate in class. The North Seattle College Jewelry Program is wonderful for allowing the Continuing Education students access to the jewelry studio and its many tools. There are consumable materials that are not provided (i.e. metal, solder, stones, etc.)

* Students are encouraged to wait to purchase materials until after the first class. All materials are available locally, but students are more than welcome to purchase supplies online.

Supply List:

All students need to bring the following studio supplies (subject to change)

- Silver wire solder (20ga, 1ft in easy, medium and hard)
- Paste or liquid flux and brush
- Fine silver bezel wire (2" minimum, 4mm width)
- Copper sheet (14ga, 4"x4" minimum, 12ga 3x1" minimum)
- Sterling silver wire (18ga 2" minimum. 20ga, 2" minimum)
- Sterling silver tube (4.5mm diameter, 1" minimum)
- 4mm CZ's (4 minimum)
- 2mm CZ's (4 minimum)
- 2 oval or circular cabochons (.2" minimum diameter)

The class will be fabricating chain, stone settings, and other projects in copper or brass. If students would prefer to use silver for their projects, it will be their responsibility to purchase the material for that as well. The metal quantities listed above are approximate amounts that will be used in class. Some students work very quickly and some work more slowly and meticulously. Plan to bring the recommended minimum, however if materials run out, you are always able to purchase more should that problem arise.
