

## Beginning Jewelry Fabrication

### Supply List

Students will be required to purchase additional materials to participate in class. The North Seattle College Jewelry Program is wonderful for allowing the Continuing Education students access to the jewelry studio and its many tools, but some consumables (i.e. solder, flux, stones) may not be provided.

**\*All materials on the list are available locally, but students are more than welcome to purchase supplies online. Students are also welcome to wait until after the first day to purchase materials nothing is required the first week of class.**

All students need to bring the following studio supplies (subject to change).

- Silver wire solder (20ga, 1ft in easy, medium, and hard)
- Handy paste flux and a paintbrush
- Sterling silver bezel wire 6” minimum
- Copper sheet (20ga, 4”x4” minimum)
- Round cabochons (2 minimum, no smaller than 1cm in diameter)

The class will be fabricating projects in mostly copper and brass. Should students prefer to work with silver or material they already have, they are more than welcome to bring materials to class but will need to have materials looked over before beginning work. The metal quantities listed above are approximate amounts that will be used in class for each project. Some students work very quickly and some work more slowly and meticulously. Plan to bring the recommended minimum. If materials run out, you are always able to purchase more.
