

# Class Supply List

## **Beginning Jewelry Fabrication Supply List**

Instructor: Ayesha Mohyuddin

### Students should purchase:

- (1) Brass Sheet 22 Gauge **Note:** 6" x 6" minimum
- (1) Cooper Sheets 18 Gauge **Note:** 6" x 6" minimum
- Bezel Wire FINE SILVER 26 Gauge 4mm width. **Note:** 4 in. minimum needed.
- Sterling Silver Wire Half Hard Round 16 Gauge **Note:** 2 in. minimum needed.
- 2 Round and/or oval cabochon stones of your choice. **Note:** Cabochons need to be a minimum of 10mm in diameter.
- (1) Easy Medium Hard Sheet Silver Solder Kit DWT each. Note: Hard, medium, and easy solder –
  1ft each wire solder OR 1 DWT each 28g sheet. Silver solder is sold in wire and sheet form. You
  will need a small amount of easy, medium, and hard solder. 1 dwt is a unit of measurement for fine
  metals. SF sells a solder kit <a href="here">here</a> with 1 DWT 28ga each sheet solder that would be perfect for the
  class.
- Jeweler's Saw Blades:
  - o (1) Jeweler's Saw Blades Size 2/0
  - o (1) Jeweler's Saw Blades Size 3/0
  - Note: You will need 2/0 and 3/0 saw blades, not 2 or 3. You can purchase a set of saw blades from size 1/0 - 6/0 here or by individual sizes here.
- Sandpaper (220, 400, 600, 800)
