# Landscape Painting with Oil 2 Instructor: Sarah Norsworthy

### **Recommended Supplies:**

- Oil Paints:
  - One 150 ml tube titanium white
  - Set of 37 ml tube paints student grade—cad red hue, ultramarine blue, cobalt blue, ivory black, cadmium yellow hue, yellow ochre, burnt sienna, quinacridone red
  - OPTIONAL: raw sienna, sap green, manganese blue hue
- Bristle Brushes/Knives
  - \*Filbert, size # 2, #8
  - \*Round, size #2, #4, #10
  - \*Flat, size #8, #12
  - 1 household brush (cheap chip brush or black foam brush) 1.5"-3" for gess
  - 3-5 palette knifes, trowel style 1 small diamond shape, 1-2
  - 1 coil brush cleaner jar (or homemade cleaning jar with wire coil or tin can inside jar with holes)
- Gamblin linseed oil 8 oz. Gambsol solvent 8 oz-16 oz. White acrylic gesso 8 oz.-16 oz
- Pad mixed media paper (18" x 24")
- \*1 wood panel approximately small to medium
- \*2 Pre-stretched Canvases small to medium
- 2 (8oz. Min.) Squeeze bottles with caps
- Disposable latex gloves

- l zip bag to store materials in or combo of backpack and plastic carrying case (I put my paints in a plastic carrying case with my palette knives, and my palette down in a backpack with my mediums, cleaning jar and paper towels, gloves, etc...)
- Artist tape white 3/4 x 60yds
- Pad of disposable palettes (or a small glass palette about 12" x 12")
- 1 drawing board to tape paper to
- 1 small notebook
- 1 pencil
- 1 eraser
- Rags or shop towels

\*If you are not going to have an easel it is best to choose a size you can hold in your hands- I am making the easel optional as not everyone can afford one and I often paint outside seated holding my painting in my hands. If you do choose to find an easel, there are pretty good deals on French easels used on Craigslist. You can also make one easily using a camera tripod and a piece of Masonite with a screw through the Masonite fastening it to the tripod.

## **Optional Supplies:**

• small folding camp chair or stool, manageable size to carry with you
