Required Supplies:

- 4.5"x6" Coloraid (314 Sheets)
- 10+ sheets of 8" x 10" (or larger) stiff white paper for mounting studies- Poster Board or construction paper are cheapest; Bristol board is more expensive, but better quality
- A couple large envelopes (new or used, 9" x 12" or larger) for carrying Coloraid once opened
- A fresh glue stick (clear, not colored)
- Reasonably fresh rubber or paper cement – a small jar (old cement gums up) OR a small jar of YES glue.
- Scissors
- Pen, pencil, notebook

Optional Supplies:

- 10-20 Plastic sheet protectors (8.5" x 11") for protecting studies and handouts
