

Intermediate Gouache

Instructor: Sam Case

For this class, you are welcome to use supplies that you already have. I like Daniel Smith or M. Graham, but they are a bit more expensive. I recommend starting with the Windsor & Newton Gouache Set (10 colors), then adding in other colors as needed. The names from that set are in parentheses.

Recommended Supplies:

- At least 10ml tubes of:
 - Titanium White (opaque white)
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Cobalt blue (primary blue)
 - Cadmium Yellow Light Hue* (primary yellow)
 - Hansa Yellow Deep (medium yellow)
 - Quinacradone Red (primary red)
 - Cadmium Red Light Hue* (vermillion)
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Sap Green (medium Green)
 - Lamp Black
- Arches Hot Pressed Watercolor Block - 7" x 10"
- Pallet knife for mixing
- Small spray bottle
- Pallet or tray for mixing

Optional Supplies:

- 10ml tubes of:
 - Yellow Ocher
 - Quinacridone or Dioxazine Purple
 - Paynes Grey (also called Jane's Grey)
- Masking Tape
- Pencil

Any paint marked as 'hue' is a cadmium-free formulation. Same great color, no potential carcinogens.

- Cadmium Yellow deep
- Cadmium Orange
