

Introduction to Landscape Drawing

Recommended Supplies:

- 2 lumograph pencils 2B and HB
- 1 package compressed charcoal or charcoal pencils (your preference)
- 1 package vine charcoal
- 1 mars plastic eraser
- 1 pad sketch or mixed media paper (size your preference)
- 1 small sketchbook
- 1 small bottle of black sumi ink (not needed first class)
- 2 sumi brushes, one small, one medium (not needed first class)
- 1 ruler
- a couple plastic cups or jars for ink wash (not needed first class)
- You may like to have a drawing board to attach larger sheets of paper to for portability, or if you have a portable easel. I try to pick spots with tables and chairs or benches, however you may wish to have this flexibility as well as a folding camping chair.
- 1 bag for carrying materials
- 4 pieces of watercolor paper or mixed media paper for working with ink or a small pad (not needed first class)
