

## Landscape Drawing 2

*These are materials you might have from my Introduction to Drawing class, or materials that you might like to use. If you would like to work with other media such as pens or oil pastels that is your preference.*

### **Recommended Supplies:**

- 2 lumograph pencils 2B and H
- 1 package compressed charcoal or charcoal pencils (your preference)
- 1 package vine charcoal
- 1 mars plastic eraser
- 1 pad sketch or mixed media paper (size your preference)
- 1 small sketchbook
- 1 small bottle black sumi ink
- 2 sumi brushes, one small, one medium
- 1 ruler
- a couple plastic cups or jars for ink wash
- You may like to have a drawing board to attach larger sheets of paper to for portability, or if you have a portable easel. I try to pick spots with tables and chairs or benches, however you may wish to have this flexibility as well as a folding camping chair.
- 1 bag for carrying materials
- 4 pieces of watercolor paper or mixed media paper for working with ink or a small pad (not needed first class)
