

Portraits in Watercolor and Gouache

Recommended Supplies:

Students are welcome to bring/use whatever they already have from previous classes.

- Arches Hot Pressed Watercolor Block - 7" x 10"
- Mop Brush, 1"
- Princeton Real Value Brush Set -9152

Tube watercolor and gouache are recommended, but you may have your paints already from another class.

Please use what you have or are comfortable using and add in the following colors:

- Gouache:
 - Zinc White (also called Chinese White) –is more transparent than Titanium/Permanent white
 - Yellow Ocher
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Burnt Umber
 - Paynes Grey (also called Jane's Grey or Perylene Black)
- Watercolor:
 - A beginners set from other classes works well, so long as you have a good range of colors to choose from. Many sets do not include purple, so you may add a tube of dioxazine purple if you'd like.
- Pallet knife for mixing
- Small spray bottle
- Folding pallet or tray for mixing
- Drawing board
- Masking Tape

Optional Supplies:

- Small sketchbook
- 2B Graphite pencil
- Kneaded eraser
