

Landscape Painting with Oils

Oil Paint:

- One 150 ml tube titanium white
- Set of 37 ml tube paints student grade—cad red hue, ultramarine blue, cobalt blue, ivory black, cadmium yellow hue, yellow ochre, burnt sienna, quinachridone red,
- Optional colors: raw sienna, sap green, manganese blue hue

Bristle Brushes & Other:

- *Filbert, size # 2, #8
- *Round, size #2, #4, #10
- *Flat, size #8, #12
- * Good to have a range of brushes, not critical to have this exact range if a size is not available
- 1 household brush (cheap chip brush or black foam brush) 1.5”-3” for gesso
- 3-5 palette knives, trowel style
- 1 small diamond shape, 1-2 longer style
- Gamblin linseed oil 8 oz. Gambsol solvent 8 oz.-16 oz. White acrylic gesso 8 oz.-16 oz.
- pad mixed media paper (18” x 24”)
- *1 wood panel approximately small to medium
- *2 Prestretched Canvases small to medium

*If you are not going to have an easel it is best to choose a size you can hold in your hands- I am making the easel optional as not everyone can afford one and I often paint outside seated holding my painting in my hands. If you do choose to find an easel, there are pretty good deals on French easels used on Craigslist. You can also make one easily using a camera tripod and a piece of Masonite with a screw through the Masonite fastening it to the tripod.

- 1 coil brush cleaner jar (or homemade cleaning jar with wire coil or tin can inside jar with holes in it)
- 2 (8oz. Min.) Squeeze bottles with caps
- 1 zip bag to store materials in or combo of backpack and plastic carrying case (I put my paints in a plastic carrying case with my palette knives, and my palette down in a backpack with my mediums, cleaning jar and paper towels, gloves, etc...)
- Disposable latex gloves
- Artist tape white 3/4 x 60yds
- Pad of disposable palettes (or a small glass palette about 12” x 12”)
